

Temporary Local Rule

10th Hole

Play Prohibited -No Play Zone

A ball played into the area defined by Pink Stakes must not be played from the area protected.

If a player's <u>ball lies</u> in this no play zone, or if it interferes with the player's stance or swing, or where it is virtually certain the <u>ball is lost</u> in this area, the player **must take relief**

either

i. by determining where the ball last crossed the outermost limits of the Protected Area within one club length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief without penalty

or

ii. proceed to the Drop Zone (defined by a Blue Square and identified by an Orange stake) at the commencement of the fairway with a penalty of one stroke.

If a ball, played from the tee, <u>strikes the bollards or ropes</u> in front of the tee, the ball **MUST be replayed**, without penalty.

If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.

Penalty for Breach of Above: The player incurs a two shot penalty in stroke play and loss of hole in match play.
