

## LAKESIDE GOLF CLUB CAMDEN - LOCAL RULES

### 1. TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES:

Temporary Local Rules may appear on notice boards at any time.

### 2. OUT OF BOUNDS:

Those areas beyond the boundary fence of the golf course.

### 3. PERMANENT ELEVATED CABLES & PYLONS:

If a ball strikes an elevated power line, cable or pylon, the ball must be replayed, with penalty, from the point nearest to where it originally laid. (Rule 20-5). If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.

### 4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR): OPTIONAL DROP EXCEPT ( C )

(a) Those areas defined by white pegs and/or white lines or otherwise so declared to conform to the requirements of Temporary Local Rule Board.

(b) Through the green animal scapes, post holes, course construction and maintenance are to be treated as "GUR".

(c) Ornamental gardens (incl wood chip areas) and practice putting greens MUST be treated as GUR. A ball lying on such ground must be lifted and dropped as provided by Rule 25-1b.

(d) Except in a hazard, wheel marks made by motorised vehicles are GUR. Relief may be taken as per rule 25-1b. (Abnormal Ground Conditions).

### 5. OBSTRUCTIONS:

All stakes, pegs, sprinkler heads, taps, seats, distance markers, watering control units, are to be treated as "Immovable Obstructions" Rule 24-2. NB – Formed or artificial surfaces of roads and paths are obstructions. All others are an integral part of the Course.

### 6. HAZARDS: All water hazards are defined as follows:

YELLOW STAKES OR LINES – Water Hazard. RED STAKES OR LINES – Lateral.

Dropping Zones for Water Hazards – where there are dropping zones, a ball may be played under Rule 26, or a ball may be dropped in the dropping zone under the penalty of one stroke.

### 7. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN (eg: Sprinkler Heads)

If a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction within two club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play the player may take relief by dropping at the nearest point of relief no nearer the hole and not on the putting green.

### 8. EMBEDDED BALL – THROUGH THE GREEN:

The specimen Local Rule page 127 is in effect.

### 9. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Devices that measure distance only may be used. Refer Appendix 1 Part B – 9.

### 10. BALL ACCIDENTALLY MOVED ON PUTTING GREEN

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is **accidentally** moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced.

## PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Stroke Play – Two strokes

Match Play – Loss of Hole

Except for 9 (Distance Measuring Devices) – Disqualification

**PLAYERS MUST:** Repair lob marks on greens, replace and refill divot holes, smooth out bunkers, carry and use a sand bucket.

**GOLF CARTS:** Do not drive golf carts across the blue lines. Approach no closer than 20 metres of greens, tees and bunkers. Maximum of two (2) persons and two (2) golf bags per golf cart. Drivers must hold a current drivers licence.

## RESERVED RIGHTS:

The Management reserves the right to exclude any person from the golf course and/or the Clubhouse.
