Holes 5, 6 7 & 8

Protected Area – No Play Zone

(Cumberland Plain Woodland Regeneration)

Local Rules Effective 1st January, 2019

Course Protection Ground Under Repair; Play Prohibited

The Protected Area on the 5th, 6th 7th & 8th holes defined by silt fencing, bollards, ropes, warning signs & the like is **Abnormal Ground Conditions (Rule 16)** from which play is prohibited.

The player **must take relief**

- if the **ball lies** in the Protected/No Play Zone or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing the player **MUST** Proceed under Rule 16-1 (f) i.e. Nearest Point of Complete Relief – one club length – no nearer the hole – Rule 16.1 (b).
No penalty.
- If the **ball is not found** and it is known or virtually certain that the ball is in the Protected Area/No Play Zone the player **MUST** proceed under Rule 16.1 (e) i.e. Take relief at the estimated point where the ball last crossed the edge of the abnormal ground conditions – one club length – no nearer the hole.
No penalty.

Penalty for Playing out of No Play Zone:

- Two shot penalty in stroke play and loss of hole in match play.

Bollards and Ropes

If a ball, played from the tee, **strikes the bollards or ropes** in front of the tee, the ball **MUST be replayed**, without penalty. If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.

8th Hole Local Rule

Effective 24th October, 2018

Play Prohibited – Protected Area – No Play Zone

A ball played into the area defined by Pink Stakes **must not be played** from the area protected.

If a player's ball lies in this no play zone, or if it interferes with the player's stance or swing, or where it is virtually certain the ball is lost in this area, the player **must take relief**

either

- by determining where the ball last crossed the outermost limits of the Protected Area within one club length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief without penalty
- or**
- proceed to the Drop Zone (defined by a Blue Square and identified by an Orange stake) at the commencement of the fairway with a penalty of one stroke.

If a ball, played from the tee, **strikes the bollards or ropes** in front of the tee, the ball **MUST be replayed**, without penalty.

If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.

Penalty for Breach of Above: The player incurs a two shot penalty in stroke play and loss of hole in match play.
