

COURSE RENOVATION WORKS

TEMPORARY LOCAL RULE

Effective 12th April 2016, the following Temporary Local Rule will apply:

Miscellaneous Course Damage

All course renovation works, including sand slits, newly seeded areas, drainage disruption and damage caused by heavy equipment, is ground under repair (GUR), even if not so marked with white lines. If a player's ball lies in such a condition, or if such condition interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player may take relief under Rule 25-1b(i): Abnormal Ground Conditions - Relief. The player may lift their ball and drop it without penalty within one club length, of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

Note: <u>Compulsory Drop Zones</u> will be provided where balls enter areas where greens are under construction. Such construction areas will be clearly marked as will the drop zones.
